When the Premier of Western Australia, Mr Mark McGowan, visited Carcoola Primary School on the 9th March he announced that our school would receive a Science Room upgrade to improve Science facilities in the school and make the teaching and learning of Science more effective. Soon after that visit, representatives of the Building and Works Department came to the school to examine the room to be upgraded and have gone away to draw up plans for the new Science Facility. More great news for our school is that we have been advised we will receive a \$25,000.00 grant enabling us to compliment our Science Room with appropriate equipment, consumables and learning materials. Such exciting news for our community, but in particular our students as they will all have the best opportunities for learning Science ever. The works are expected to commence next term and be completed by the end of the year.

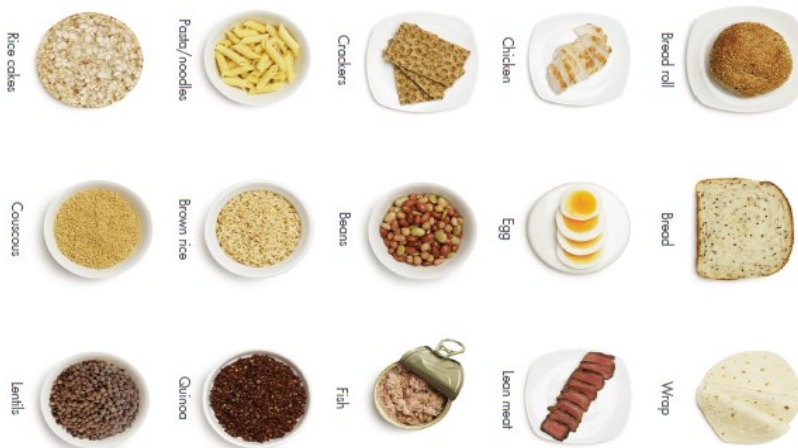
Have these raw, cooked or canned and choose a variety of colours and textures.
